Notes:

The FY 2016 House Ag Approps bill directs USDA to continue and expand the Section 502 Intermediary Pilot Program and to submit a report to the Committee on the criteria used to define "rural in character" in determining eligibility for housing programs. FY 2016 final bill sets aside \$75M of rental assistance for renewals within a 12-month period. The FY15 provision prohibiting renewals during the contract term is not in the bill. The bill requires the Secretary to report to Congress quarterly on the number of renewals approved during the preceding quarter, the amount of RA available, and the amount needed for the balance of the fiscal year. The FY 2016 final bill directs USDA to continue and expand the Section 502 Intermediary Pilot Program.

The FY 2017 Budget Request proposes to fund SHOP at \$10M as a set-aside within the HOME program.

The FY17 Senate bill includes language to allow nonprofit owners to receive a Return on Investment and an Asset Management Fee. It also would create a pilot program to provide Technical Assistance to facilitate transfers to nonprofit and new owners. The bill also requires that USDA report quarterly on the status of Rental Assistance funds.

The FY 2017 House bill directs USDA to continue and expand the Section 502 Intermediary Pilot Program, and allows tenants to obtain vouchers in properties with maturing Section 515 mortgages. It also directs USDA to provide Congress with the criteria it uses to determine whether a community is "rural in character."
