At the same time, federal solutions with a proven track record of reducing homelessness and housing poverty are sorely underfunded. As a result, just 1 in 4 poor families that are eligible for rental housing assistance get the help they need.

We can solve this crisis without adding any costs to the federal government by reforming the Mortgage Interest Deduction. The United for Homes campaign, which I endorse, lays out simple reforms that would give 15 million more homeowners a tax break—including many homeowners with low or moderate incomes—and would generate \$241 billion in savings to help families with extremely low incomes.

Now is the time. Please work with your colleagues to reprioritize and rebalance scarce federal housing resources to serve families with the greatest needs.
