
OUT of REACH 2017 FACTS OVERVIEW

WAGES NEEDED TO AFFORD RENT ACROSS THE U.S.



IN 2017, THE 2-BEDROOM NATIONAL HOUSING WAGE IS

An American household must earn at least **\$21.21 an hour** to afford a modest, twobedroom apartment without spending **more than 30% of income on rent**. This wage varies from state to state.
