For renters and landlords

Need help paying rent and utility bills?

The CCERA program provides assistance to renters in **Cameron County** who have been financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic to pay current and past due rent and utility bills.

Both landlords and renters can apply.

Households must have incomes at or below 80% of the Area Median Income and meet other eligibility requirements.

What costs does the program cover?

The CCERA program can help renters with the following costs starting as far back as March 13, 2020:

- Past due, current and up to 3 months of expected rent costs
- Past due, current and up to 3 months of expected utility and home energy expenses
- After the initial 3 months of forward assistance, you can apply for 3 additional months of assistance if funds are still available.
