MAPLE STREET FLATS & WESTSIDE PLACE APARTMENTS

New construction in Missoula 1, 2, 3 or 4 bedrooms \$698-1,536 per month

Maple Street Flats at 2200 Mullan Road

Westside Place at 1600 block of **Cooley Street**

Amenities include:

- Central heating and A/C
- Dishwasher
- In-home laundry
- · Community room, playground
- Secured entry
- · Off-street parking
- · Individual storage area

Income eligibility: Households earning 70% or less of the area medium income can apply. For Missoula residents, this means a household of two people earning \$41,000 or less per year may qualify for a home. Housing Choice (Section 8) Vouchers welcome!









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- "The two biggest barriers are provider capacity and sustainable funding."
- Of the 14 options listed on the study sheet, Armstrong said that only one has sustainable funding, that being Blue Heron Place – a permanent supportive housing project at the new Trinity apartments. But even that project lacks the long-term sustainable funding needed to provide supportive services in its navigation center.
