WHAT DOES IT COST TO JOIN?

Annual membership dues ensure that all members have a stake in the coalition's collective success. Many NLIHC members live on low incomes or small operating budgets, which is why all membership dues are suggested amounts. Members can join or renew at any amount that is affordable to them. Below are the suggested annual dues rates for different memberships.
