What is 811 Project Rental Assistance (PRA)?

- A federal rental assistance program funded by HUD
- State Housing Finance agencies partner with state
 Medicaid or Health and Human Service agencies to:
 - Allocate 811 PRA rental assistance to affordable housing development projects in the state
 - Identify and refer low-income people with disabilities to the housing
 - Ensure the availability of supportive services for tenants who chose to access them

811 PRA Overview

- 811 is a project-based federally funded subsidy
- 811 serves households where at least one member must have a disability and be between the ages of 18 and 62.
- 811 is integrated permanent supportive housing

Project-Based Rental Assistance

811 is project-based rental assistance

- Attached to the housing unit
- Tenants pay 30% of their adjusted monthly income for rent and utilities
- Applicants typically apply for (or select among) specific properties or buildings

Tenant 811 Eligibility

- Extremely low-income (ELI)
- Non-elderly person with a disability
- Member of the state's "target population"

Integrated Permanent Supportive Housing

- No more than 25% of units in a PRA project may be targeted to people with disabilities
- 811 provides tenants with access to voluntary tenancy support services
- 811 is permanent housing

811 PRA Program Highlights

3,000

Since 2015, over 3,000 ELI households have moved into 811 PRA units.


92%


92% of households served have maintained their housing or had positive exits.

8,750

811 PRA will produce 8,750 units of housing for ELI people with disabilities.



FY 2024 811 PRA NOFO

- In October, HUD's Office of Multifamily Housing Programs announced \$106 million in new 811 PRA funds
- States with existing programs and those without existing PRA programs are encouraged to apply
- Applications require partnership between the state Housing Finance Agency and the state Medicaid or Health and Human Services office.
- Applications are due February 12, 2024
