


FIGURE 9: SEVERELY COST BURDENED EXTREMELY LOW INCOME RENTER HOUSEHOLDS

Note: Mutually exclusive categories applied in the following order: senior, disabled, in labor force, enrolled in school, single-adult caregiver, and other. Senior means householder or householder's spouse (if applicable) is at least 62 years of age. Disabled means householder and householder's spouse (if applicable) are younger than 62 and at least one of them has a disability. Unemployed means household and householder's spouse (if applicable) are younger than 62 and unemployed. Working hours is usual number of hours worked by householder and householder's spouse (if applicable). Enrolled in school means householder and householder's spouse (if applicable) are enrolled in school. Nearly 11% of severely cost burdened extremely low income renters are single-adult caregivers of a young child or disabled person, three-quarters of whom are in the labor force and three percent of whom are in school.
